
TIP 7. INVITE COMMUNITY MEMBERS



Engage members of the community most impacted by the session topic.



Cultivate future student experiences at community sites.



Teach community and population-focused issues.



Provide reflective questions to prompt students to relate with the community.

TIP 8. SCHEDULE THE SESSION



Ensure students from all programs can be there. Merge calendars, consider mandatory or creative options. Be aware of student learning timelines.



TIP 9. SECURE AN APPROPRIATE LOCATION



TIP 10. PREPARE FACULTY AND OTHER FACILITATORS



Provide facilitator training. Interprofessional facilitation is a unique set of teaching skills.

TIP 11. GENERATE ENTHUSIASM



Collect registrations and make table assignments.



Market the session.



Present IPE at scholarly and faculty meetings.



Share information.

TIP 12. EVALUATE THE SESSION



Provide an opportunity to integrate information, faculty assessments of student performance, and feedback. Reinforce session learning objectives with post-session activities.
